Imperial International School Ipoh celebrates its first IGCSE cohort class of 2021, as they received their Cambridge IGCSE results on August 12.

The pioneer batch of students achieved a 100% passing rate with 90% of all grades at A\*-C, 88% A\*-B, 76% A\*-A and a 47% of A\*s. Chew Jia Hui, a scholar of the school, topped the chart by achieving straight A's (6A\*s and 2A's).



It has been a very demanding year for Imperial students, and all have worked incredibly hard to overcome many challenges of the pandemic, to gain their qualifications and move forward with their next educational steps.

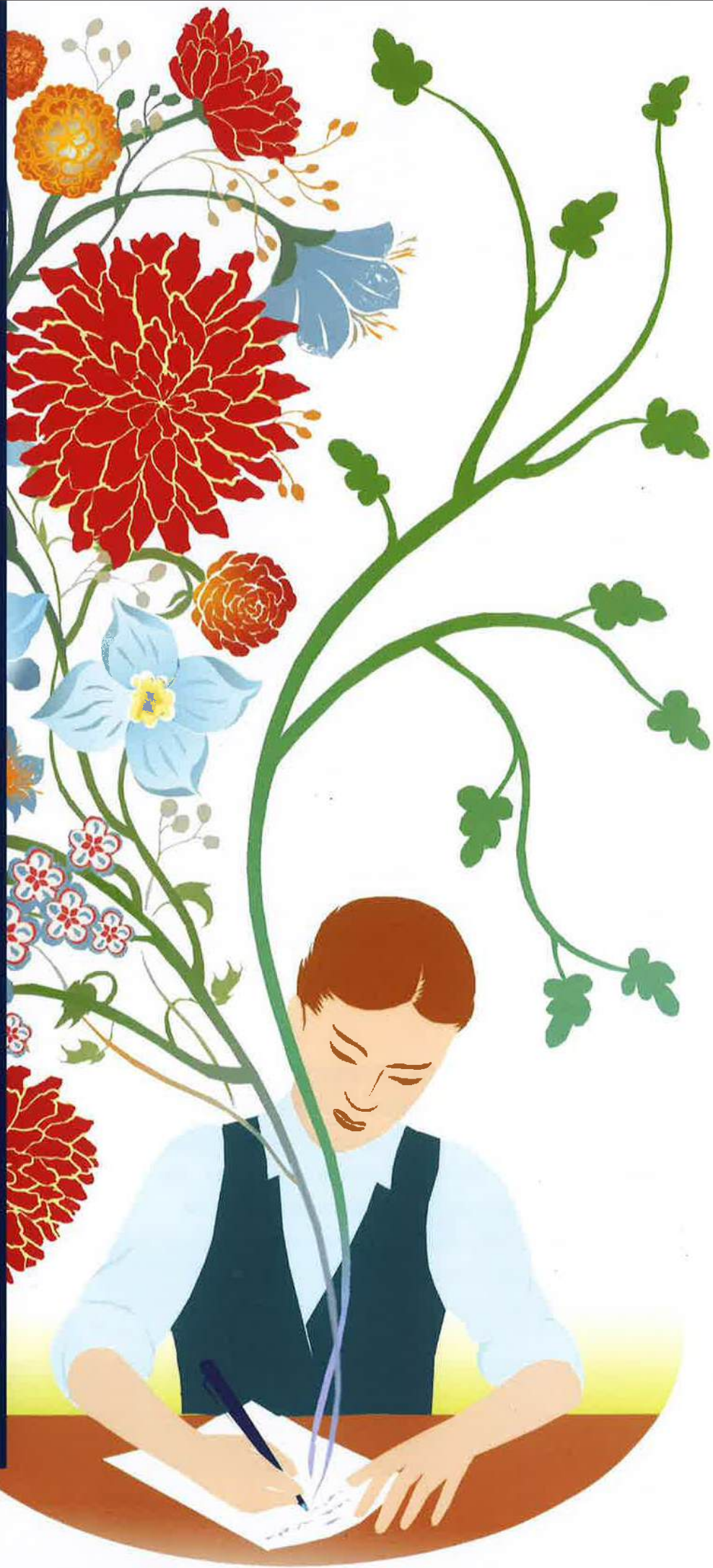

Huraikan pendapat anda tentang cara-cara menguruskan kewangan yang boleh dijadikan sebagai panduan agar menjadi pengguna bijak.

Panjangnya huraian hendaklah antara 200 hingga 250 patah perkataan.

Pada era globalisasi ini, sektor perniagaan telah mengeluarkan pelbagai produk yang telah menarik perhatian orang ramai. Hal ini dikatakan kerana masyarakat sudi memabazirkan masa dan bangun pada waktu tengah malam untuk membeli barang pada atas talian kerana promosi-promosi yang dipromosikan oleh perniagaan. Oleh itu, masyarakat hanya membeli apa yang mereka suka tanpa menguruskan wang dengan bijak. ~~Permasalahannya~~, apakah cara-cara menguruskan kewangan yang boleh dijadikan sebagai panduan agar menjadi pengguna bijak?

Konklusinya, terdapat banyak cara untuk menguruskan wang dengan bijak. Bak kata pepatah, sediakan payung sebelum hujan. Kita mestilah menyimpan wang yang mencukupi supaya dapat ~~menyelesaikan~~ <sup>apabila</sup> masalah mendesak. Oleh itu, kita perlulah ~~bermula~~ <sup>kan</sup> mengguna dan menguruskan duit dengan berjimat-cermat.
