
This is my second time of learning in an international school and also, my last for my secondary education.

Imperial International School Ipoh celebrates its first IGCSE cohort class of 2021, as they received their Cambridge IGCSE results on August 12.

The pioneer batch of students achieved a 100% passing rate with 90% of all grades at A*-C, 88% A*-B, 76% A*-A and a 47% of A*s. Chew Jia Hui, a scholar of the school, topped the chart by achieving straight A's (6A*s and 2A's).

As long as I work hard, I can be extraordinary!




