Student Council Visit to HRPB Paediatric Unit

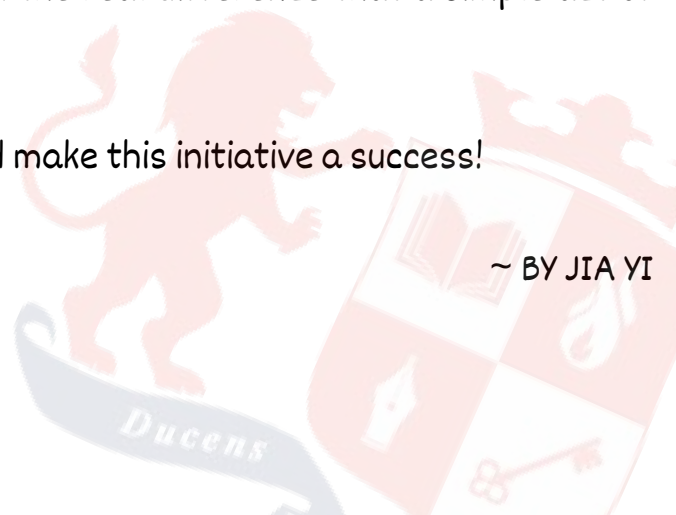

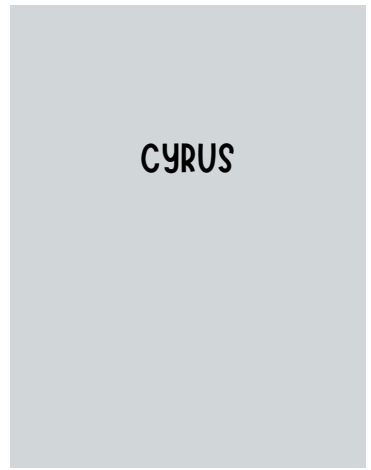

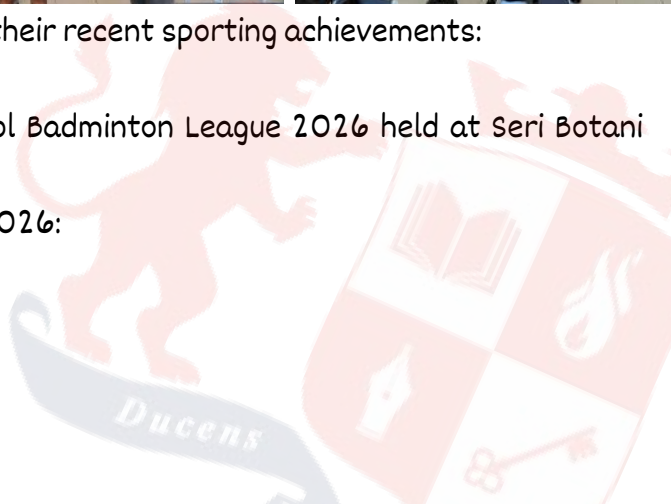
Sports Awards

Readers Today, Leaders Tomorrow

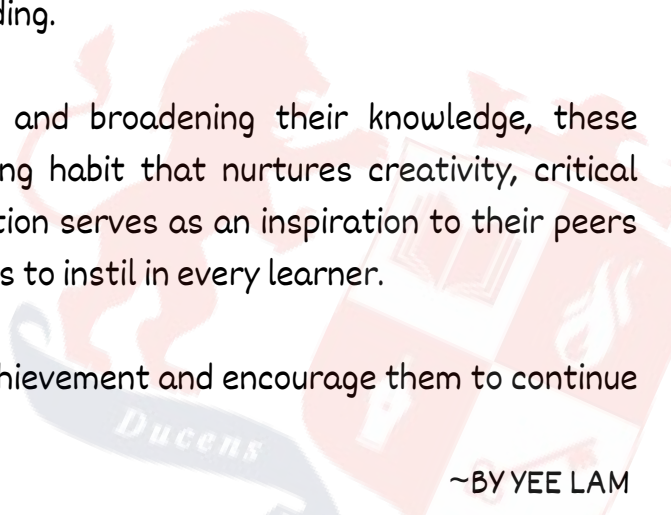

Year 3 presentation: How to deal with exam stress?

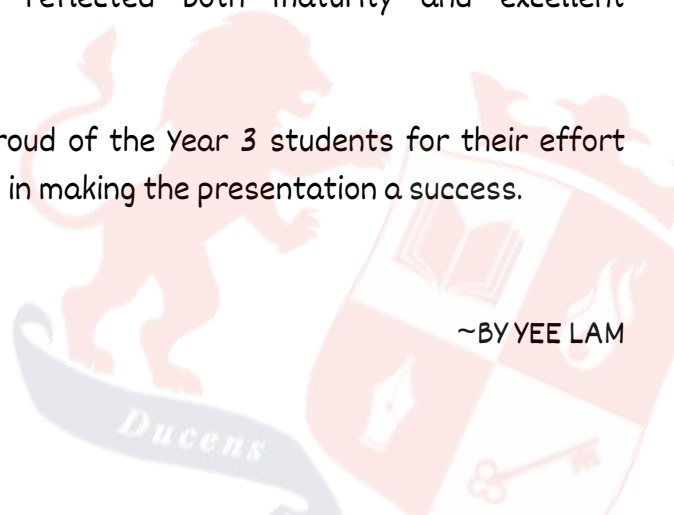
