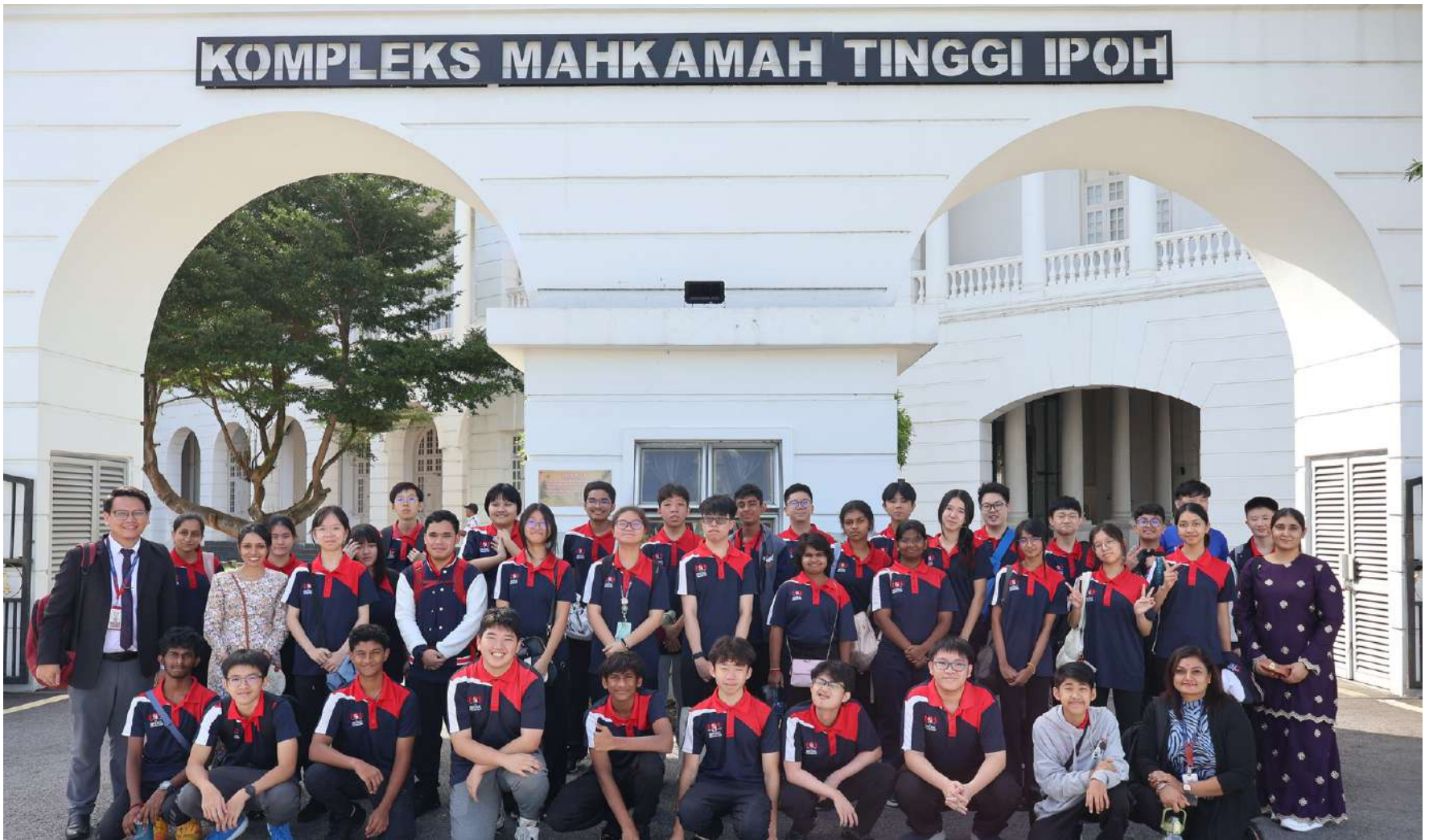

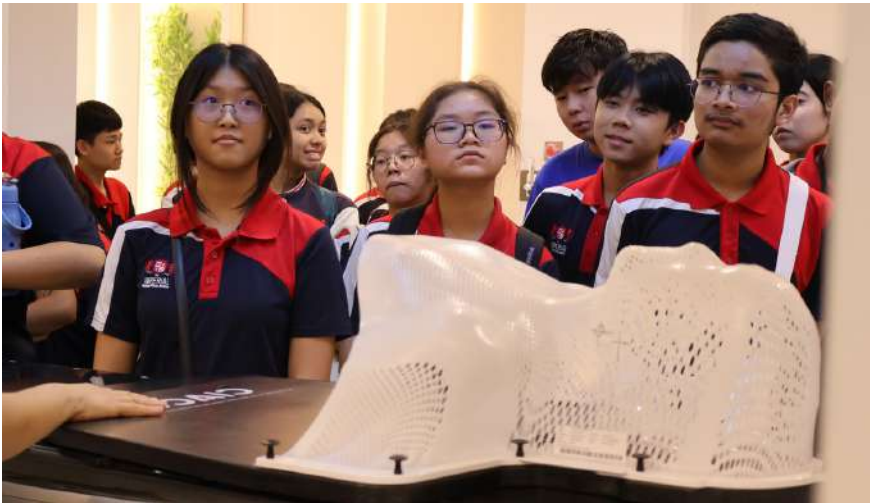
Exploring these diverse, real-world environments was an entirely new experience for the students, sparking curiosity and offering them a fresh perspective on potential future careers!

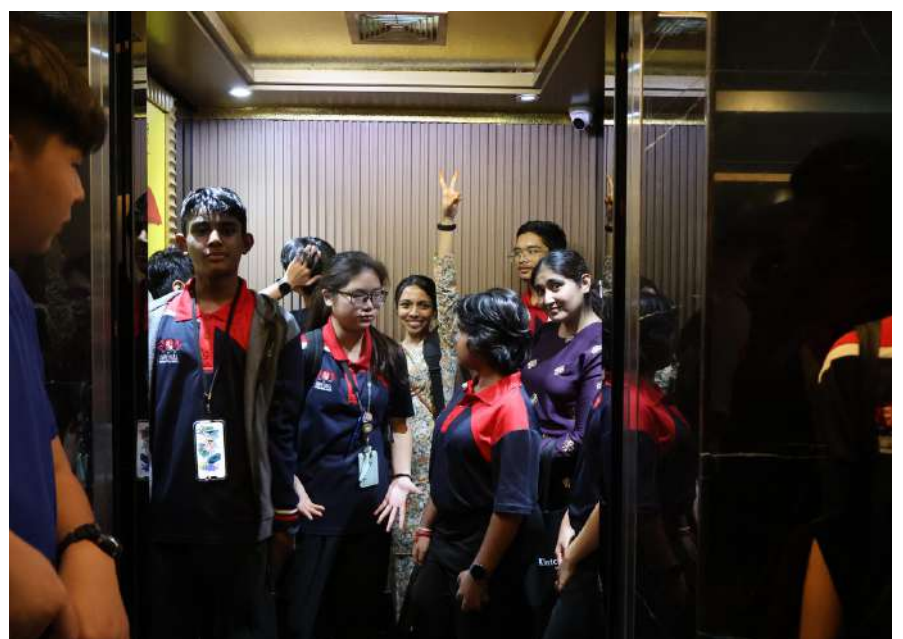
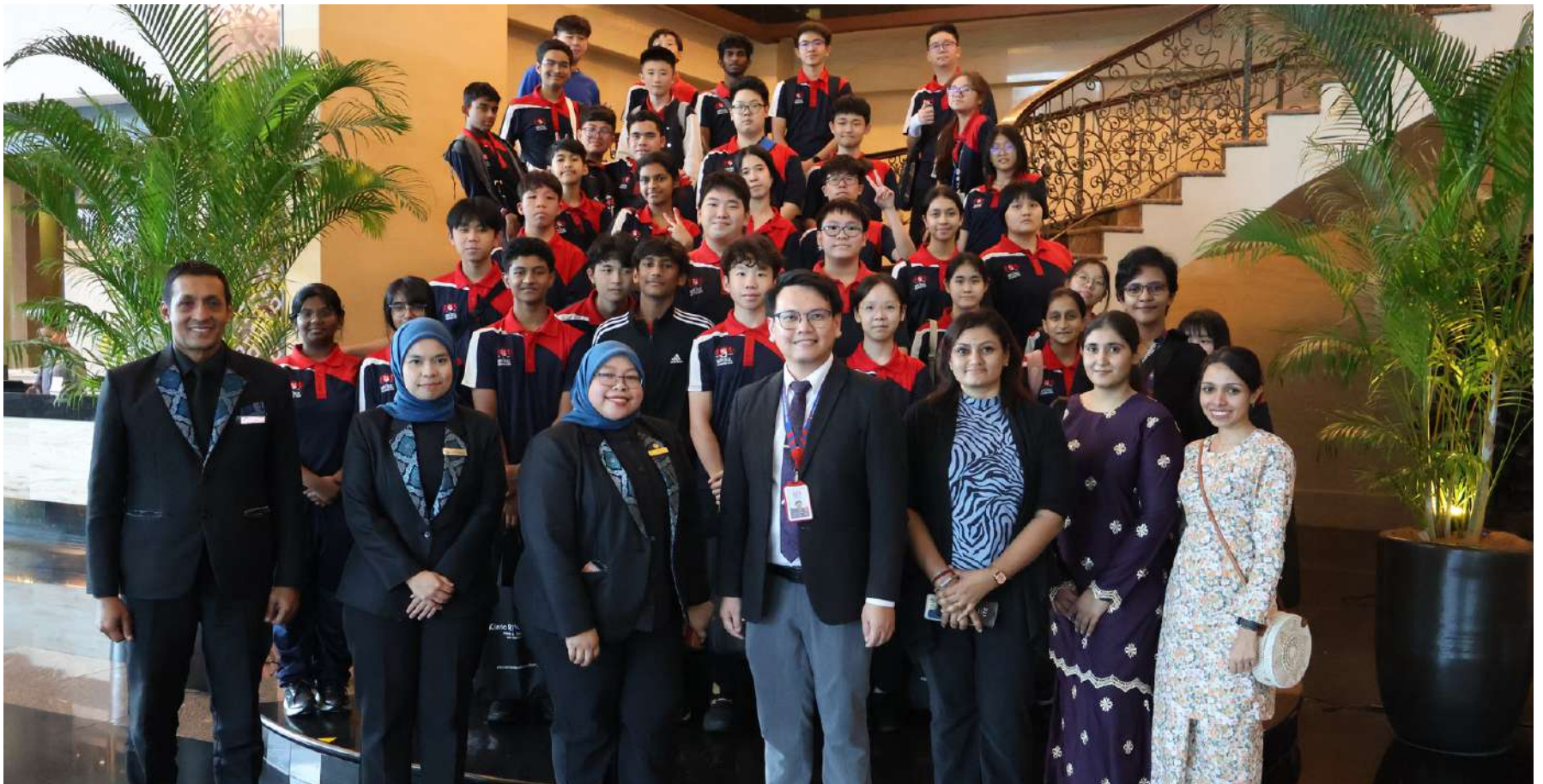
First stop: Ipoh High Court

Exploring Higher Education at SEGi University



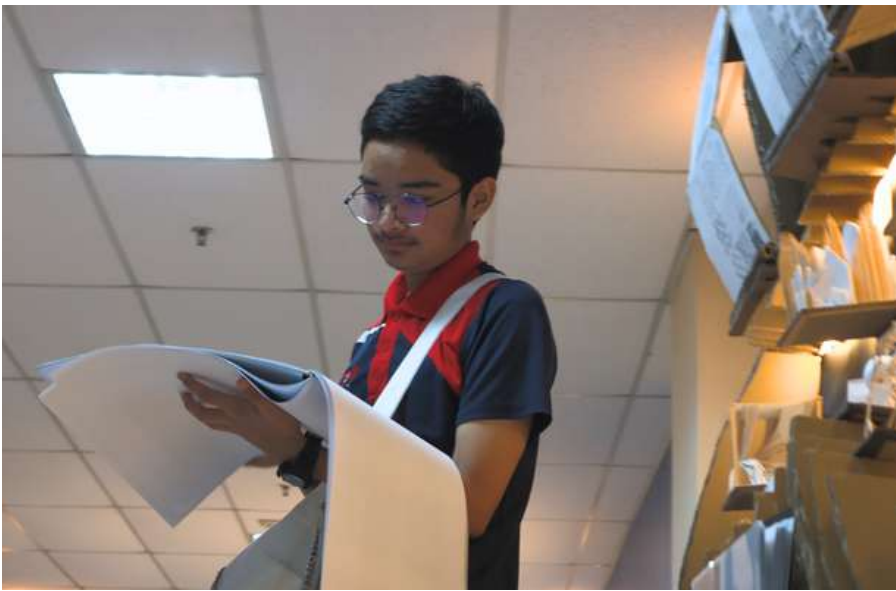
