Celebrating Cambridge Checkpoint Achievements

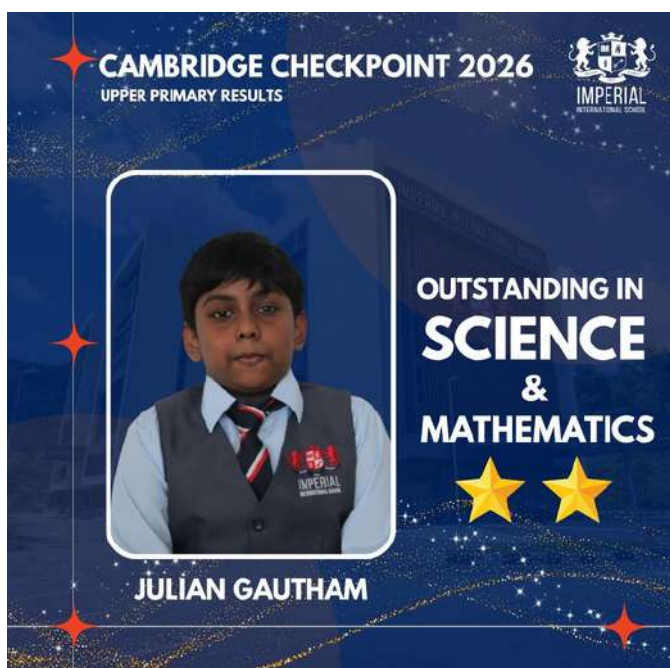

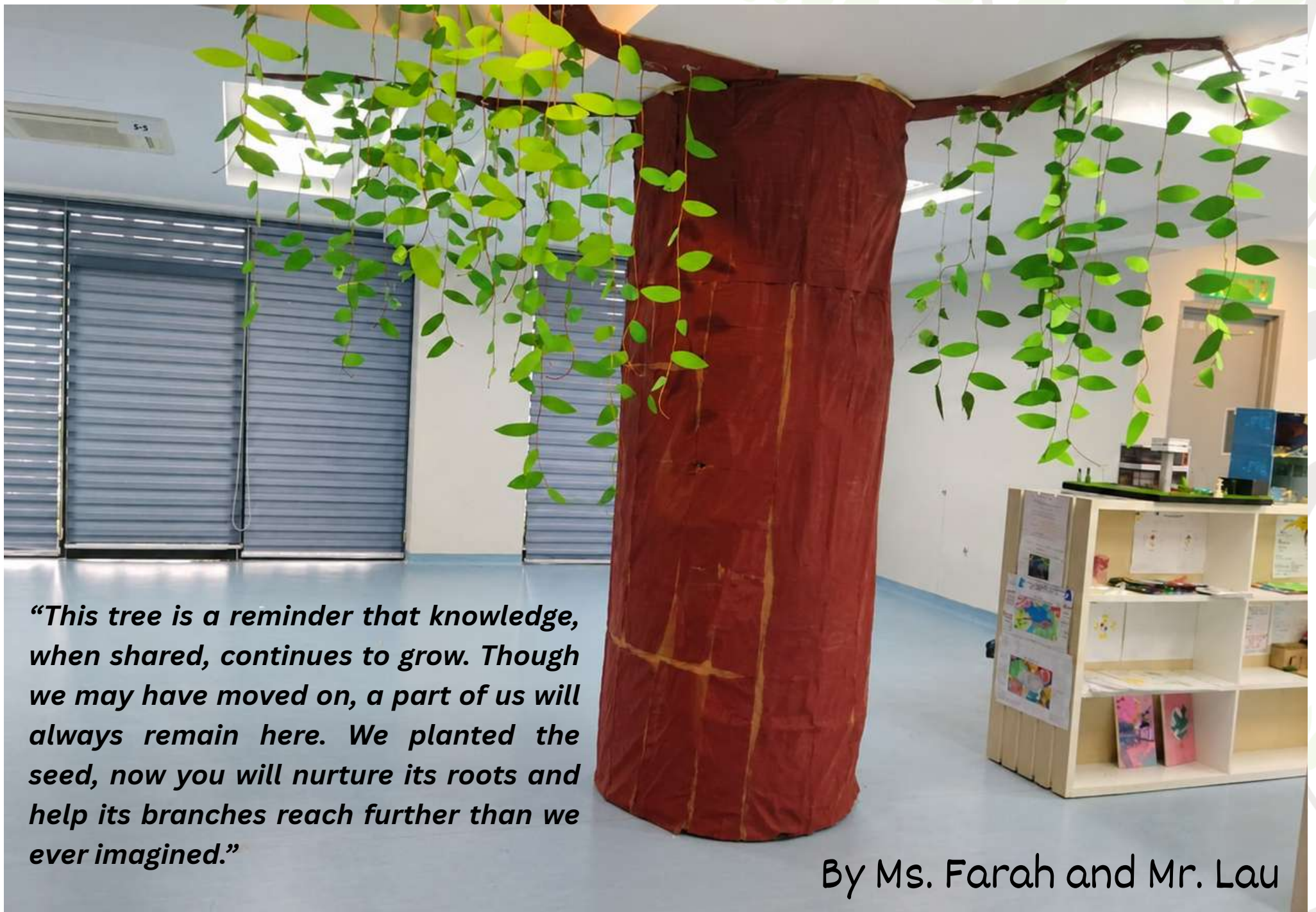
Mr. Lau Ken Hang
